



THE LAND THAT STONE OWNED ... Stephen Stone owned 13 of the 14 tracts of land shown here at one time, and the 14th became the property of his heirs after his death. Stone secured the tracts of Mount Pleasant, Delight, Dromore, Garvachy, Belelly, Rathfryland, Conclusion, Joseph & Mary, James & John, Washington, Tendragee, Lurgan and Down Patrick from Detmar Basse Muller in 1808. He sold the first six, those in the southeast corner, to Gabriel de Fombelle in 1809, and the others to John Hull (his brother-in-law) and John Purviance in 1810. James & John, Washington, Lurgan and Down Patrick were sold back to Stone in 1823, however. Stone built a brick house in Washington that still stands (see arrow). The 14th tract, Wagerston was purchased by Stephen Stone's heirs in 1841 and sold to Henry Druschel in 1845.
