

LIVESTOCK ORDINANCE

**MARION TOWNSHIP
BEAVER COUNTY
PENNSYLVANIA**

**ADOPTED OCTOBER 3, 1978
AMENDED JULY 13, 1998**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO REGULATE
THE MAINTAINING OF LIVESTOCK IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF MARION, BEAVER COUNTY, AND
PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS
THEREOF AND REVOKING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES
CONCERNING THIS SUBJECT MATTER

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township Supervisors
of the Township of Marion, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, a Township
of the Second Class, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by
virtue of the authority granted in the Second Class Township Code,
as amended, as follows:

Section 1. Title

This Ordinance may be known and may be cited as the
Marion Township Livestock Ordinance.

Section 2. Definitions

Unless otherwise expressly stated the following words
and phrases shall be construed throughout this Ordinance to have
the meanings herein indicated:

(a) "Person" shall include any partnership, assoc-
iation or corporation.

(b) "Township" shall mean Marion Township, Beaver
County, Pennsylvania.

(c) "Livestock" shall mean any domestic animal
maintained or kept by persons within the Township and shall include
but not be limited to horses, cattle, sheep, pigs, goats, donkeys,
mules, but excluding dogs and cats.

Section 3. Violations

No person in the Township shall permit livestock to roam at will. It shall be the duty of all persons in the Township to maintain livestock on the premises of such persons, whether said premises are owned or leased, and failure to do so shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Penalties

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof at summary proceedings as provided in the Second Class Township Code as amended, be sentenced to pay a fine according to the following schedule:

Upon the first conviction, not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars.

Upon the second conviction, not less than Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars.

Upon the third conviction, not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

Upon the fourth conviction, not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Upon the fifth conviction, not less than One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars.

Upon the sixth conviction and any subsequent convictions, the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

Providing, however, no fine imposed at any one time shall exceed the sum of \$300.00; and providing further that any persons so convicted must pay an addition to such fines, any and all costs or prosecution and in default of paying any such fines or costs shall be confined in the county jail for a period of not more than Thirty (30) days.

Section 5. Severability

If any Section of this Ordinance shall be found to be invalid, the other Sections of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Repeal

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective Thirty (30) days after enactment by the Board of Supervisors.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 78-1 OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MARION, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO REGULATE THE MAINTAINING OF LIVESTOCK IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, BEAVER COUNTY, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND REVOKING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES CONCERNING THIS SUBJECT MATTER.

BE IT ORDAINED and it hereby is ordained by the Township of Marion, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the terms of the authority granted it under the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. Section 67511, Ordinance No. 78-1 of the Township of Marion is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. (c) - DELETE

SECTION 2. (c) ADD

(c) "Livestock" shall mean any domestic animal maintained or kept by persons within the Township and shall include but not be limited to horses, cattle, sheep, pigs, goats, donkeys, mules, chickens, llamas, alpacas, but excluding dogs and cats.

SECTION 4. DELETE

SECTION 4. ADD

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof at summary proceeding as provided in the Second Class Township Code, as amended, be sentenced to pay a fine.

Providing, however, no fine imposed at any one time shall exceed the sum of \$300.00; and providing further that any persons so convicted must pay in addition to such fines, any and all costs of prosecution and in default of paying any such fines or costs shall be confined in the county jail for a period of not more than ninety (90) days.
